Please email, text or ring to let us know if you would like to come and if you could help before or during the camp. If you've been to an APODC camp before it's a no-brainer!!!




Their generosity allowed us to make the event at Crystal Mountain just a little bit more special for families. We appreciate their benevolence and know you will join us in supporting them in the future.
